'One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding around him and listening to the word of God. He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat. When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." ... Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.'

In the bible there are many references to fishing. This is because the first disciples called by Jesus were fishermen. Fishing was their occupation - it was how they made their living. However, Jesus told them that they would be fishers of people - they would go and tell people about the Kingdom of God. Jesus also wants us to be fishers of people. Therefore we should tell people that we meet all about the love of Jesus so that they can follow him too.
