FORWARD THINKING...

We have always prided ourselves on our forward-thinking PCC.

After an exciting 'pitch' by Tony Whitehead, the PCC unanimously agreed funding for a Projector and a screen to be installed in Church. This is to enhance primarily our TFG worship but also our other services too. It will be an important interactive tool in our growing technological society. It is hoped that our young people will use this and take part more. We are hoping this will encourage the Academy to engage more with us too.

Here is what Tony had to say;

"Mission should be second nature to Christians but sometimes we need the tools to do this effectively and to engage the young as well as older. We must accept that the technology is here to stay and will only get more and more and better and better and I want to ensure that St Bede is equipped to face this head on and be future proofed for all eventualities. This piece of equipment can be used in multiple ways; and this will be the dawn of a new era to St Bede."

IT ALL COSTS MONEY!

The volunteers we have in Church do an excellent job and they give up their own time for free. Imagine how much it would cost if we had staff to pay!

It is worth mentioning, that to keep our doors open week in week out costs approximately £850.00 a week. That's around £20.00 per adult/family unit based on an average adult attendance of 43

That includes heating, electric, parish share and other bills.

This is why fundraising is so important to our Church. We need to 'top up' our regular giving. There are other ways we can accomplish this, Legacy gift for example.


Parable

Meet our new Mission Partnership Administrator

Hello from the Church Administrator for St Andrew's and St Bede's.

My name is Elaine Almond and I took up my post on 4th June, working around 10 hours a week flexibly across both Churches, spending some of my time actually in St Andrew's. This is a 3 year contract and is a new post for both Churches. I am currently finding my feet with the help of the Church wardens, due to the current clergy vacancy.

The aim of the post is to provide administrative support to the clergy team and be a first point of contact for matters relating to St Andrew's and St Bede's.

Responsibilities include:

- To assist with the administration of baptisms, weddings and funerals
- To assist in ensuring that appropriate statistics are collated for Diocesan requirements
- To Assist with the preparation of publicity for Sunday services
- To manage room bookings and invoicing

This list is not definitive but will develop as the post becomes embedded and I'm sure the new incumbent will have ideas of their own.

Although I'm enjoying my retirement I'm also very excited to have the opportunity to work with both Churches in this new role and hope I can count on your support in this new venture.
