During today's prayers, please come up and write a member of your family or friends on one side and a one-word prayer on the other side, such as 'hope' or 'peace'. We will then tie these together and display in church during the rest of Advent and during Christmastide

Star Secret: at a family Christmas gathering, write each person's name on a star. Put them in a basket or a hat. Each person then draws out a name and during the day, they secretly find a way of being as star for that person who's name they chose. If you draw your own name put it back!

THE ADVENT WREATH

The Advent wreath is four candles on an evergreen wreath. The perfect circle of the wreath symbolises the eternity of God. Each Sunday during **Advent**, one of the four red candles on the wreath is lit to symbolise the coming of Jesus Christ. As each candle is lit we focus on one of the four virtues Jesus brings us: Hope, Love, Joy and Peace. The white central candle, called the Christ candle is lit on Christmas Day reminding us that Jesus is the light of the world. The Advent wreath continually reminds us of whom we are called to be as followers of Jesus.

Colour your own advent wreath to keep as a reminder that Jesus is the Light of the World and that we await his second coming
