Church Rocks and Shiny Pebbles

The Parable of the Sower

'The one who received the seed that fell on good soil is the man who hears the word and understands it.' *Matthew 13:23*

Jesus liked to tell parables to help people understand his teaching. Parables are stories that illustrate religious teachings. One day he told a story about a farmer who planted some seeds. The bible reading today, Matthew 13: 1-9 and 18-23, tells us the story. The farmer scattered the seeds in his field. Some of the seeds fell on the footpath, some fell on rocky ground, some fell amongst the weeds and some fell on good, fertile soil. Jesus' parable wasn't just about planting seeds, it has a much deeper meaning - the seeds represent the word of God and the soil represents the people who hear it. Listen carefully to the reading, to find out what happened to the seeds. What kind of soil are you? Do you hear God's word and put it into practice in your daily life?
