## **Editorial**

For Christians fasting and prayer often go hand in hand,

'Paul and Barnabas appointed elders for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, committed them to the Lord, in whom they had put their trust.' (Acts 14)

Christians believe that the purpose of fasting is to take a person's focus away from the things of the world and onto God. Fasting and prayer is believed to be a way a person gains a new perspective and a renewed reliance upon God. Fasting should never be used in order for a person to boast about their superior spirituality but it should be done in a spirit of humility and a joyful attitude. Matthew 6:16-18

'When you fast, do not look sombre as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.'

## Church Rocks & Shiny Pebbles



After Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist, in the river Jordan, it was time for him to do the work the Father had sent him to do. Jesus had to be sure that he made the right decisions and so, guided by the Holy Spirit, he went into the wilderness (a very lonely place), so that he could spend time with the Father. During this time he would give his love to the Father and know that the Father loved him, and he would spend time deciding on the future plans that God the Father wanted him to do. Jesus spent 40 days and 40 nights in the wilderness fasting and praying, to prepare himself for the difficult things that were to come.

The season of Lent began last Wednesday (called Ash Wednesday). Today is the first Sunday in Lent. Just as Jesus had 40 days in the wilderness, Lent is the 40 days (not counting Sundays) leading up to Easter. It is a time when we can think and pray about all that Jesus has done for us and how we can best serve God and do what he wants us to do. Some people make a promise to give something up during the 40 days of Lent, for example, not eating chocolate or sweets, not playing on the X-box or Playstation, giving up social media, etc. Others observe Lent by promising to do good for other people, such as collecting food for the Grub Tub for Urban Outreach, filling one of the St Bede's film boxes with 20 p coins, doing chores for family and friends, 40 random acts of kindness, etc (visit https://40acts.org.uk/ 40 days, 40 reflections, 40 challenges to make a difference). Just as Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness in preparation for his ministry, Lent is a good time for us to dedicate ourselves to following Jesus; to draw closer to God.
