Most of you who were in Church last Sunday will have heard Malcolm announce that St Bede's Priest in Charge, John Armstrong will be leaving St Bede's and St Andrew's in April to take up a new Parish in Yorkshire. A. change can sometimes be unsettling for a Church, particularly for a church like St Bede's where it may feel like we have had more than our fair share of interregnums and changes in Priests-in-Charge. However, we have 'ridden the storm' of doubt and uncertainty in terms of who will lead us as a Church family before and by sticking together and supporting each other, we will come out of it again, challenged, but stronger and united.

We understand that the Diocesan policy is not to advertise for a replacement until the present incumbent has left. Naturally, this will leave a period where we will be without an actual "Priest in charge" although we believe that the overall responsibility will lie with the Area Dean until one is appointed. We will be heavily reliant on Malcolm and Pat and Carol and Gill to lead us in our worship and mission and we are blessed to have a team of such dedicated and talented people at the helm.

The PCC will be closely monitoring the situation and will be ensuring that our own Team are supported and that the needs and views of St Bede's Church are well represented in the new appointment.

It has been a real pleasure to have welcomed John and to have been able to work alongside him in our mission here at St Bede's. We will have an opportunity to say our formal goodbyes to John I am sure, but in the meantime, we wish him and his family all the very best in John's new posting.

Urban Outreach wish to thank the congregation of St Bede's for your continued support through the Grub Tubs. 


# WEDDING GUEST TURNS WATER INTO WINE
