LEAVERS SERVICE

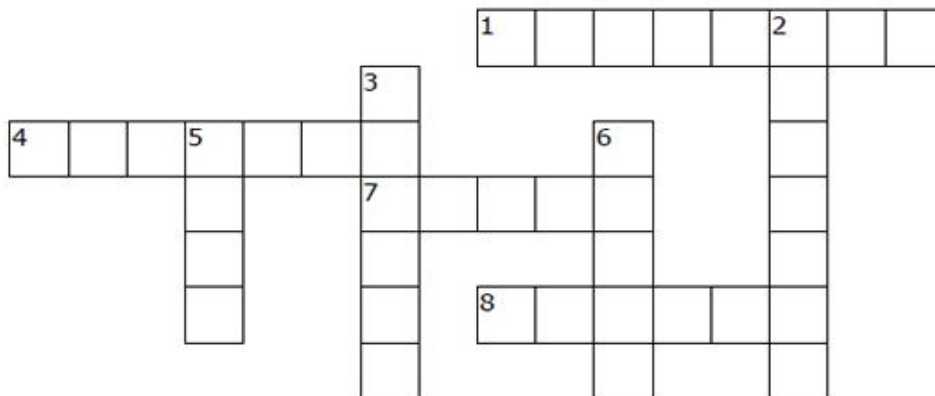
