Editorial

So begins a wonderful story, a story set once upon a time, in a land we call holy, in a time we now know was exceptional. This magnificent story begins with an angel named Gabriel who came to a teenaged girl named Mary to tell her that she would be a part of God's Wonderful Plan: You shall bear a son, the angels told her, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. [Luke 1:31,32] Our Gospel lesson reminds us that in its essence our Christian faith is an extended story, a once upon a time account of the wonder and power of God. To speak of Jesus and to tell of God's plan for salvation is to tell a story. Indeed, those who have tried to make of Christianity some kind of theological system or an elaborate moral code have done a great disservice. Christianity is none of that. It is a story, a captivating story that appeals to our senses, makes us want to lean forward in our chairs to listen, and then slowly enfolds us. Please remember that stories are not simple diversions or entertainments. No, there is enormous power in a good story. A good story draws us in and helps to define us.


Please try to support the social and fundraising events as they are vital not only to the financial wellbeing of our Church, but are great opportunities to get to know one another better.
