Editorial

Many years ago, when Paul was writing Colossians, a heresy was beginning to infiltrate God's church. Some were teaching things about Jesus that were simply not true. Some denied that Jesus was God in the flesh. Others believed other things about Jesus that were not true. Paul wrote the book of Colossians with the main purpose of refuting these false teachings concerning the Christ. In the same way, we have many today who teach false things about Christ. The New Age Movement teaches that Jesus is one of many Spiritual Masters. The Jehovah Witnesses claim that Jesus is not God, but the archangel Michael. The Mormons teach that Jesus is not God but one of many gods and is the spirit brother of Lucifer. The many other heresies floating about in the religious world today are legion

What Paul has to say to us about Jesus in today's reading from Colossians is significant. If we are to believe in Jesus, we must know who Jesus is. Before us is one of the most complete descriptions of who Christ is in the New Testament. And today, as we learn who He is we must exalt His name as Most Holy God, Saviour, and Creator.




