Editorial

We don't know for sure that Luke was a doctor, through there are several things in his work that make it likely, as well as Paul's mention of him as 'Luke, the beloved doctor' (Colossians 4.14). But if he was, there must have been an ironic smile on his face when he wrote verse 43 in today's gospel reading. Perhaps he knew patients like that who had spent everything on medical attention and it still didn't make a difference.

The message that Luke gives us would be one he would repeat to us today, in whatever problem or suffering we face. The presence of Jesus, getting his hands dirty with the problems of the world, is what we need, and what in the gospel we are promised. As we live inside Luke's developing story, we find Jesus quietly coming alongside us in our own muddle and fear. He welcomes our trembling touch and responds with that central biblical command: **'Don't be afraid.'**
