Editorial

Today we will witness signs of life – a new addition to our family. – part of the worldwide family of God. Through baptism, we have each been sprinkled, each been adopted, washed & welcomed into the Love of God. It is a time of celebration, of wonder and a time of discovery as a whole new way of life opens before us – we forsake the old and with eyes being opened – we start to look forward to new possibilities.

Matthew tells us not to worry about life & the body – about food and drink and clothes but rather to focus upon the spiritual – that may not be good advice for new parents, having to think about mealtimes & bath times, nappy changing etc but the passage says "Do Not Worry". 
