BIBLE OVERVIEW COURSE

Our Church depends very heavily on fundraising as well as regular giving to keep our Church afloat. We work very hard to put on different events, but we need these events to be supported if they are to be successful in raising funds and providing opportunities to share fellowship as a Church.

Local News



You may not be aware, but the CLC Christian Bookshop in Bolton is closing at the end of January 2020 and we have been called to continue and expand the ministry locally.

From the early days when George Verwer from OM (Operation Mobilisation) opened the Wesley Owen bookshop in 1964, there has been a Christian Bookshop ministry here in Bolton. In 2009 CLC International (UK) took on the shop, but due to a change in direction and the fact the YMCA are due to knock the building down in April, the CLC bookshop closes on 30th January.

Why do we feel a calling to carry on this ministry?

We believe there is a need for a Christian presence in the high street, providing easy access to the Gospel. People currently come to find a peaceful atmosphere, to talk about their needs and for prayer.

In the past people have come to faith through our ministry in the shop. Our aim is to reach people through Christian Literature, and encourage them in their walk with God.

Along with supporting individuals we would like to partner with local Churches and equip them with the resources they need. So, here is the really exciting bit: *We are moving!*

The lease has been agreed and pending the legalities being dealt with, we are hoping to open in Unit 1, 2-5 Crown Street, in early to mid-February as 'Isaiah 53 Christian Bookshop'.

To serve the local community, David Thurairatnam will be the Shop Manager, and many of the existing team have offered to continue volunteering, which is an amazing answer to prayer, as is the support of the local Church.

We have already setup a not-for-profit limited company with five directors with a range of professional experience, leadership roles and of course a living relationship with Jesus; once established we hope to register as a charity, with profits planned to be routed to local projects.

Being a 'Kingsway CLC Trust Partner Shop' means we will be able to offer the best support to our customer base with rapid fulfilment of orders. The basic setting up costs are not too high as we have support from the Kingsway CLC Trust, and some friendly builders, however, to get established as quickly as possible, we do have some financial needs that we would ask kindly for you to pray over and see whether you feel called to partner with us financially as well as prayerfully.

The main things we need funds for are:

- # Supply of flooring materials and having them laid.
- # Stud wall with door to create a storeroom.
- # Alteration to existing partition wall to create a small office.
- # Supply and installation of a suspended ceiling.
- # Alterations and improvements to electrics.
- # Supply and installation of two heating units.
- # Supply and installation of LED lighting panels.
- # Signage design, fabrication and installation.
- # Health & Safety surveys.
- # Till system.


