#### **APCM 2020**

Our Annual Church Meeting is coming up on Sunday 5th April at 11.30am (following the morning service). All are welcome as we celebrate all that God is doing in the life of St Bede's Church. If you wish to vote or stand for a position at the APCM you need to be on the electoral roll. If you are not currently on the electoral roll and would like to be on the electoral roll applications are now available from the back of church. You must be over 16, resident in the parish or be regularly attending for 6 months to be on the electoral roll.

At the APCM we also elect new PCC members for a period of 3 years. This year we have 4 spaces on the PCC. If you wish to stand to be a member of the PCC, you need to write your name on the list at the back of church and be nominated and seconded by 2 church members by Sunday 29th March. If there are more nominations than places, then there will be an election at the APCM.

#### **REVISION OF THE ELECTORAL ROLL**

The revision of St Bede's electoral roll will take place between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 15th March. After such revision the electoral roll be displayed on the notice board in the foyer for inspection.

Under the Church Representation Rules any persons are entitled to have their names entered on the roll, if they:

- (1) are baptised and aged 16 or over;
- (2) have signed a form of application for enrolment; and either
- (3) are members of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England being resident in the parish or (not being resident in the parish) having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to the application for enrolment; or
- (4) are members in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity declaring themselves to be also members of the Church of England and having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

Forms of application for enrolment can be picked up at the back of Church or see Elaine Almond Electoral Roll Officer.

In order to be entitled to attend the annual parochial church meeting and to take part in its proceedings, forms of application for enrolment must be returned by the 15th March for the ending of the revision of the Church Electoral Roll by the Parochial Church Council.




