Please see the message below from Rt Revd Mark Ashcroft, Bishop of Bolton, about the cancellation of the Believe in Bolton Mission led by John Sentamu, Archbishop of York planned for the weekend of 15th to 17th May 2020.

Dear friends,

I am very sorry to say that we have taken the decision to cancel the Believe in Bolton Mission in May.

We have taken this decision with a heavy heart after taking heed of Government advice, the Archbishops' letter and in consultation with Archbishop Sentamu's office.

We are obviously very disappointed that the many events that have already been planned and prepared for cannot now go ahead. The Mission would have brought churches and Christians together, it would have given opportunities for hundreds of people to think about what they believe and to hear the stories of many people whose lives have been transformed by Jesus Christ; the mission would have brought an outstanding Christian leader, Archbishop Sentamu, to Bolton because he and we do believe in Bolton.

However, our first priority must be the health and well-being of our people and we could not do the Mission without significant numbers of people gathering together with all the risks that involves.

Thank you so much for your support and prayers.


Church Rocks & Shiny Pebbles
