ST BEDE'S VISION NIGHT

REVISION OF THE ELECTORAL ROLL

The revision of St Bede's electoral roll will take place between 1st March and 15th March. After such revision the electoral roll be displayed on the notice board in the foyer for inspection.

Under the Church Representation Rules any persons are entitled to have their names entered on the roll, if they:

- (1) are baptised and aged 16 or over;
- (2) have signed a form of application for enrolment; and either
- (3) are members of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England being resident in the parish or (not being resident in the parish) having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to the application for enrolment; or
- (4) are members in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity declaring themselves to be also members of the Church of England and having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

Forms of application for enrolment can be picked up at the back of Church or see Elaine Almond Electoral Roll Officer.

In order to be entitled to attend the annual parochial church meeting and to take part in its proceedings, forms of application for enrolment must be returned by the 15th March for the ending of the revision of the Church Electoral Roll by the Parochial Church

CORONAVIRUS GUIDANCE RE: COMMUNION

The Church of England has issued some guidance concerning tightening up on hygiene around the distribution of communion. In particular at St Bede's the advice is not to dip the bread wafer directly into the wine if that is your practice and if you are feeling unwell, you should refrain from drinking the cup at communion and simply receive the bread. It is worth noting that Coronavirus has been graded a low risk to individuals however by following these simple guidelines we hope to minimize the risk of infection.

Our Church depends very heavily on fundraising as well as regular giving to keep our Church afloat. We work very hard to put on different events, but we need these events to be supported if they are to be successful in raising funds and providing opportunities to share fellowship as a Church.

Church Rocks & Shiny Pebbles

In the bible reading today from St John, 1:35 - 42, we hear that Jesus' first disciples were Andrew and Simon Peter. After speaking with Jesus, the first thing that Andrew did was to go and find his brother, Simon Peter, to tell him. He then brought Simon to Jesus. He shared his faith with his brother.

Sharing our faith with others is not always easy - telling people about Jesus can sometimes be daunting. However speaking to other people about our beliefs can lead them to Jesus, so that they too can have a deeper relationship with Him. Sharing faith with people takes courage, but it is worth it. Sharing our faith with others can, not only make us stronger, but can also lead them to true freedom in Jesus. There are many ways in which we can share our faith; we can talk to others about Jesus; we can encourage them to read the bible; we can encourage them to pray; we can invite them to come to church. Sometimes sharing our faith can be as simple as making a difference in the lives of those people that are around us through simple acts of kindness. Look for ways to help others, such as encouraging someone at school who is alone to join your friendship group; to help someone who is upset or hurt; to show respect to other people; to make a positive difference to someone else. These are ways in which we can share Jesus with others and live our faith.


