It is called the "problem of suffering" or "the mystery of evil". It's a question that Christians have been grappling with for millenniums. The question of natural suffering, from illnesses or natural disasters, differs from that of moral evil, which would be like Hitler's actions. The truth is no one really knows the answer but God. People could argue that it's to teach the world a lesson, but others could argue that means He is not all-loving. One thing we do know for certain, though, is that God hasn't abandoned us. The Lord promised us in the Bible, multiple times, that He will never forsake us or leave us in our time of need. He is still walking by us, and the world, helping us get through this terrible time. Where is God? God is with us. Romans 8:38-39 declares that "For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord". Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, God is guiding His people. No virus will ever be able to separate us from God's love and power. He will continue to fight for us, but we have to trust in His plan.




