Editorial

The book of Psalms ends in 150:6 with the memorable exhortation: "Let everything that has breath praise the LORD." This is an invitation to join the whole chorus of creation in the ongoing, vibrant praise and worship of God. Praise is the climax of the book of Psalms.

Psalm 1:2 echoes God's word to Joshua in 1:7-8: "Be strong and courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night.... In other words, Ps 1 as a foundation to the journey of faith calls us to a courageous willingness to read and ponder.

What about us? Do we have the courage to read Scripture, breathe it in moment by moment, and breathe it out through a life of faithfulness, justice, and love as witnesses to God's kingdom? The courage to pick up the Scriptures and read is a key step in the journey and life of faith that ends in the perpetual praise of the God who saves us through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus our LORD.

Our Church depends very heavily on fundraising as well as regular giving to keep our Church afloat.


