In Luke Chapter 10, an expert in the law asked Jesus, "Who is my neighbour?". Jesus replied by telling the story of the Good Samaritan. The parable of the Good Samaritan (which you can read in Luke Chapter 10, verses 25 to 37) is probably one of the best known of all Jesus' stories. Jesus demonstrated that everyone is a neighbour. He tells us "Love your neighbour as yourself".



Amongst our neighbours, are people of different colour and different ethnic backgrounds, people of different age groups, people of different faiths, people of different Christian denominations. Jesus loves us all and loves our differences and He wants us to love our neighbours in the same way too.
