A QUESCION OF FAICH

It's back to school time again! Some of you may be feeling excited and some of you may feel nervous because of all the new things that you will have to face. You may have new teachers, some new friends, and some of you may even be going to a new school

When you are back at school, the teacher will probably ask some questions to see how much you already know. In our Bible reading today, the disciples are asked questions by their teacher. Their teacher is Jesus. Jesus often took his disciples aside to teach them important lessons about the Kingdom of God. In this reading, Jesus asks Peter a direct question, "Who do you say I am?" Peter cannot hide behind other people's views - he needs to make his own mind up. Peter is prompted to stand up for his faith and proclaim his faith in Jesus. When we are asked the same question, how would we answer the question of faith?
