'THE GLORY OF THE CROSS' JOINT LENT COURSE 2021

The season of Lent begins this month and we are delighted to announce details of our joint St Andrews and St Bedes Lent Course entitled 'The Glory of the Cross'. The course is a 6 week course, beginning on Wednesday 24th February at 8pm on Zoom.

The course is based on Tim Chester's book 'The Glory of the Cross' – which comprises of 7 weekly themes and a small reflection for each day from Ash Wednesday – Easter Sunday which takes us through John's Gospel and explores how the cross is the most glorious moment in history.

Everyone who registers for the Lent Course will receive a copy of the book which we will hand deliver to you before Ash Wednesday. Alternatively copies of the book will be available at the back of church from this Sunday if you would prefer to pick up your copy yourself.

During the Lent Course we will be splitting up into breakout rooms and there will be space to chat and share what we've read in the past week. The book itself is very small and easy to read so you don't have to do lots of reading beforehand.

If you'd like to sign up to do the course and to receive your book then e-mail Vinny asap (vinny@st-bede.org.uk) and we will let you know the Zoom details for the course.

If you are unable to join us on Zoom because you don't have the technology – we would still be happy to drop you a copy of the book which you can use as part of your personal devotions during Lent.

There is no charge if you want a copy of the book but if you want to make a donation to cover the cost we would suggest \pounds_5 .

The Glory of the Cross will also be our focus during our services in Lent. We hope you will be able to join us as we journey towards Easter.


A Mountain Top Experience

'Then a cloud appeared and enveloped them, and a voice came from the cloud: "This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to Him!"' Mark 9:v7

The Bible reading today, tells us that one day Jesus took Peter, James and John high up into the mountains so that they could be alone. While on the mountain top, Jesus' appearance changed. His clothes became a dazzling white, whiter than any bleach could get them. Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking to Jesus. Peter exclaimed, "Teacher, it is wonderful for us to be here! Let's build three shelters -- one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." Then a cloud passed over and covered them. From the cloud came a voice saying, "This is my Son, and I love him. Listen to what he says!" Then when they looked again, they saw only Jesus.

Have you ever been to a mountain? There are often beautiful views to enjoy from the mountain top; you can clearly see the beauty of the world below. Some people go the mountains to get away from the hustle and bustle of everyday life, to relax and admire the beauty of creation. I imagine that Peter, James, and John would have been happy to stay up there on the mountain top with Jesus, but did they? No, Jesus knew that the purpose of their experience on the mountain top was to renew their strength for the difficult days that were ahead of them, so he led the disciples back down from the mountains into the valley. They encountered Jesus, our Immanuel, and responded to him. How can you encounter Jesus and respond to him in your life?
