

'When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.' *Acts 2:1-4 (NIV)*

Today is Pentecost Sunday. It is a day that we remember and celebrate a very special event in the early days of the church. When Jesus told his disciples that he was going to return to heaven, he promised them that he would ask the Father to send another helper to be with them. That was a wonderful promise that Jesus gave his followers, but the disciples weren't really sure exactly what that meant. They were gathered together in one



place and suddenly, they heard a sound like the rushing of a mighty wind. Next, they saw what appeared to be tongues of fire that came to rest upon the heads of each one of them and they were filled with the Holy Spirit and they began to speak in other languages. The Holy Spirit is still with us today and lives in the hearts of the followers of Jesus. The Holy Spirit guides us in the decisions we make each day, and calms our fears and fills us with hope.
