Heroes of the Old Testament: Sarah

Reading: Genesis 18 v 1-15

Abraham and Sarah faithfully followed God and moved to a new land which God had promised them. God also promised that Abraham and Sarah would have a family that would become a great nation - God's chosen people. Yet Sarah was old and well past childbearing age and had no children. When a messenger of the Lord told Sarah that within the year she would give birth to a son, she laughed. But God says (v 14) 'Is anything too hard for the Lord?'. Within a year Sarah gives birth to Isaac (Gen 21) and Sarah says (v 6) "God has brought me laughter and everyone who hears about this will laugh with me". VINNY'S LICENSING SERVICE

We are pleased to announce that the Bishop has now lifted the suspension of the parish of St Bede (legally the parish has been suspended for the last 5 years due to the changes and reorganisation of churches that St Bedes is linked with). In reality this means very little; but it was the reason why Vinny was originally licensed Priestin-Charge rather than Vicar/Incumbent.

Now the suspension has been lifted; Vinny will now formally be licensed as Vicar/Incumbent and this will take place on Tuesday 27th July at 7.30pm at St Bedes. It will be a short service; but an opportunity to pray for ourselves as a church. All are welcome if you wish to attend.

IMPORTANT COVID-19 UPDATE

As you are aware, all legal restrictions on public worship have now been lifted by the Government. For some people these new freedoms bring great relief and joy, for other people the changes bring worry and anxiety. The need to continue to be a church community where we love one another and respect each other's opinions and find a way to support one another is vital. Taking all this into account; St Bedes PCC have agreed the following way forward which balances everyone's needs.

Therefore from this Sunday:

- We will still be encouraging you to **sign in** and use the Test and Trace system.
- We strongly encourage anyone attending church to continue to wear their **face covering** when at St Bedes unless exempt. Mitigating factors such as these will reduce the need to self-isolate if there is a confirmed case in church. (even though we have had very few instances of confirmed cases in church anyway)
- We will be maintaining the **social distance** measure in church of using every other pew. Once all the pews are full; we will start to fill up the empty pews from the back but encourage people to sit in the middle of the pew so they maintain distance. If you are keen to maintain social distance measures we would suggest you sit towards the front of church.
- We will still be continuing with the practice of distributing bread only at communion.
 This will be continue to be reviewed however.
- Paper versions of the weekly newsletter will be available for you to pick up from Sunday 15th August; and you are also welcome to pick up hymn books/service sheets. However all services will continue to be on the screen so there is no need for you to have a book/sheet if you would prefer not to.
- Singing will return in church from Sunday 1st August
