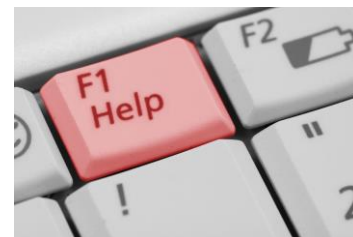

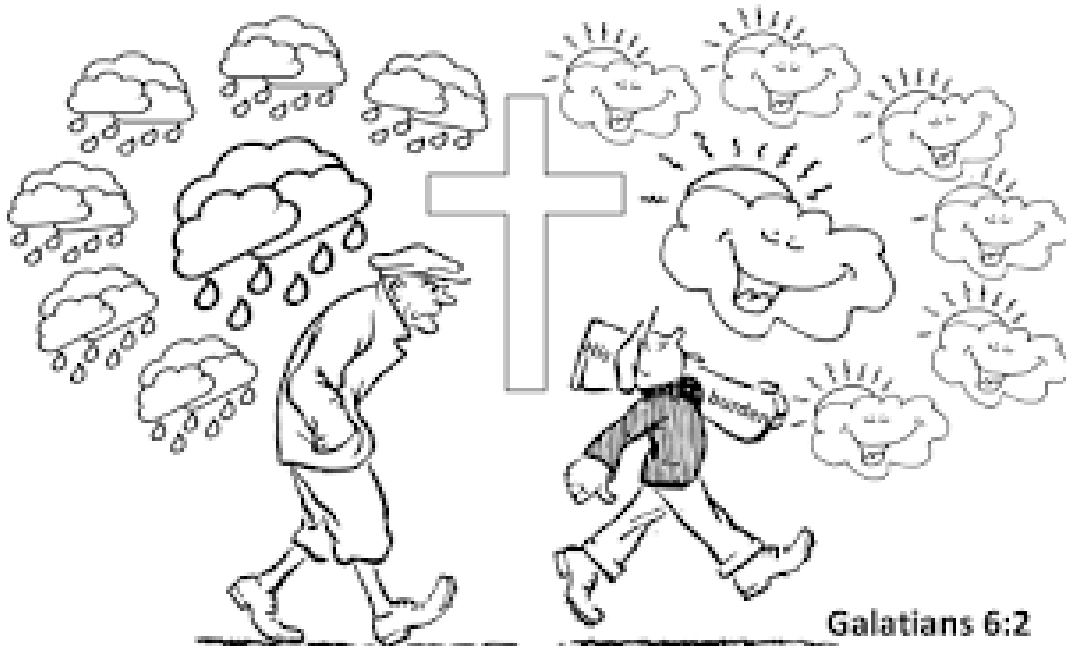
Church Rocks & Shiny Pebbles

'Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ'. *Galatians 6:2*

The Bible teaches us to "bear one another's burdens." Sometimes we may have a friend who is going through some difficult times and needs someone to help carry their burden. Maybe our friend is sick, sad, or lonely. Many times, we don't even have to say anything or do anything. We just need to be there and let them know that we care.
