## Heroes of the Old Testament: Gideon

Reading: Judges 6 v 11-16

Times are hard for the Israelites; they had lost sight of God and they were constantly being attacked by the more powerful Midianites. God calls Gideon to lead his people. Gideon objects "My clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my family' (v 15). Yet through God's power, Gideon defeated the Midianites - with just 300 men after sending away nearly 32,000 men because he trusted in God's great power. In our own lives there are often times when we feel weak and helpless - but when we trust God and His great power, we can do anything.




"The Lord is with you, you mighty warrior."
