CHRISTMAS DINNER OF JESUS 2021

This Sunday we are launching our Christmas Dinner on Jesus Campaign 2021 with our biggest challenge yet!

Our challenge as St Bedes and St Andrews is to collect **1700 packets of luxury biscuits** by **Sunday 5th December!**

The luxury biscuits must be between 200g-250g to fit in the hampers so please: don't bring in large selection boxes of biscuits. Examples of luxury biscuits are: Borders Biscuits, Small Boxes of Cadbury's Fingers, Supermarket brand Luxury Boxed Biscuits etc. As we want to be a blessing to our local community - please don't bring in standard biscuits such as digestives, custard cremes etc.

Please start collecting now and start bringing them into church! Each Sunday we'll do a count, so we know how many we have collected so far.

Christmas Dinner on Jesus is organised by our church charity partner this year: Urban Outreach who wish to bless 1700 local people in need with a free Christmas Dinner. On **Sunday 21st November** at our 10am service, the CEO of Urban Outreach, Dave Bagley, will be preaching at St Bedes.
