#### **2022 ST BEDE CHARITY PARTNER**

Then PCC met this week and made a decision on one of our charity partners for 2022 - FORTALICE

Fortalice provides frontline services including a refuge with 22 flats, training and group work for victims who are, or have been affected by domestic abuse and violence.

Their services support women, men, families, children and young people in Bolton and the surrounding areas. Survivors are invited to engage with group work or individual sessions to address the abuse they have lived with. They work to promote and ensure a future free from abuse and educating young people is a key part of their service.

Since the organisation was established in 1977 they have provided support, education and advice to thousands of families. Staff have a wealth of specialist skills, expertise and knowledge in this area.

The Standing committee are also considering another local charity. Information will be issued when it is available

# St Bede Vision Statement 2021-2026



### Our Vision – Living for Jesus at the Heart of our Community

Throughout the years, St Bede's Church is a focal point for our local community here in Morris Green. Many people in our community see St Bede's as their church even if they don't attend on a Sunday. Our central role within our community is further strengthened by our close relationship with St Bedes Academy, the largest primary school in Bolton with 600 pupils and serves as the main school in Morris Green.

Our vision as we look to the future is to be a church community that is centred on Jesus and a church community that lives for Jesus. As we ourselves experience the transforming power of Jesus in our lives; we long to see the transforming power of Jesus transform our local community.

Central to our vision statement is Paul's prayer for the church in Ephesians 3 v 14-21. We believe that "God is able to do immeasurably more than all we can ask or imagine" (Ephesians 3:20) as we look to the future.

### Our Journey So Far...

St Bedes is a medium sized church with 68 members on its electoral roll. We are blessed that our church family has a wide range of ages including a substantial number of children and young people. We are growing in terms of our diversity; with members of our congregation originating from as far away as Pakistan and Africa. St Bede's is located at the heart of the Morris Green community and seen as the community church. Large numbers of our community come through our doors through our links with our church school, St Bede Academy.

### Where are we going?

Our desire at St Bedes is to be a **growing** church as we live for Jesus at the heart of our community. We want to be a church which grows up, in and out.

As a church community we want to grow **up** in our own experience and knowledge of God and to encounter the power of Jesus in our own lives.

As a church community we want to grow **in** love for one another and be a church community where we welcome all and support one another as we seek to live for Jesus.

As a church community we want to grow **out** as we seek to live for Jesus. We long to see our wider community transformed by the power of Jesus that is at work in us and to see people come to know and experience Jesus for themselves.

In terms of numerical growth, our goal is in 5 years time; St Bedes will have grown by at least 20%. This means that by 2026 we will have a membership of at least 80 people or more!
