

Being Sent

Reading: Luke 10 v 1-12, 16-17

In our reading, Jesus sends out 72 of his followers to go out into the town and villages on a mission to tell people about Jesus. As Jesus' followers we too are called today to be on a mission as we point those whom we meet to Jesus. To do this we need confidence and courage (v 2-3), compassion (v 8-9), connect with people (v 5) and to convert by explaining the good news (v 9). Last Wednesday was Ash Wednesday, which marked the first day of Lent. Ashes are something that are left when something is burned. Christians use them as a symbol of being sorry for things they have done wrong and want to get rid of forever. The ashes come from last year's palm crosses which are burned and mixed with holy water.

Lent is the period of six weeks leading up to Easter, the most important festival in the Christian calendar. The last week of Lent is called Holy Week. Lent allows Christians to remember when Jesus went into the desert to fast and pray before beginning his work for God, during which time He was tempted several times by Satan, but was able to resist. Lent is a time of giving things up and a test of self-discipline and some people give up something they really enjoy, such as cakes or chocolate or biscuits.

CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

Notice is hereby given that the Church Electoral Roll will be revised by the PCC beginning on Sunday 6th March and ending on Sunday 20th March.

Under the Church Representation Rules any persons are entitled to have their names entered on the roll, if they:

- (1) are baptised and aged 16 or over;
- (2) have signed a form of application for enrolment;

and either

(3) are members of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England being resident in the parish or (not being resident in the parish) having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to the application for enrolment;

or

(4) are members in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity declaring themselves to be also members of the Church of England and having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

Forms of application for enrolment can be obtained from the back of Church. In order to be entitled to attend the annual parochial church meeting and to take part in its proceedings, forms of application for enrolment must be returned by the 20th March for the ending of the revision of the Church Electoral Roll by the Parochial Church Council.

Any error discovered in the Roll should be reported to the undersigned.
