#### **Easter Sunday**

Reading: Luke 24 v 1-12

The Easter story is full of surprises. The empty tomb itself, the discovery by Mary and probably other women and their proclamation to the disciples of the resurrection. Not recognising Jesus. Yet like a joke we've heard before how do we let God surprise us through it? Perhaps this year more than any with the sense of loss from the pandemic we need to look to that lovely meeting between Mary and Jesus. He greets and consoles her and you get that sense of a special caring coming from Jesus. Mary has an outburst of emotion (who would not) and just wants to give Jesus a hug and hold on to him. How often in this pandemic have we missed the simple touch of a handshake or hug?

We do ask people not to dip bread into wine as this is unhygienic and there may be members of our congregation who are gluten intolerant.

We will also be bringing back **the peace** where you can shake peoples hands. Again please be mindful of those who would prefer to avoid contact.

We also will be passing round the **collection plate** during the service and presenting our offering at the communion table.

Please start to bring back your filled film boxes. Ideally, we need them back next week.




