Luke 24 vs 36-48

'Look at my hands and feet. It is I myself' (Luke 24: 39)

One of the fascinating aspects of the Easter narratives is how Jesus' friends and followers struggle to recognise the Risen Jesus. In Luke's Gospel, both Cleopas and his companion and the disciples in our reading this morning at first struggle to recognise Jesus.


In the excitement of Easter, we forget that the Bible makes it very clear that Jesus' appearance has changed since his resurrection. Jesus could appear and disappear.

suddenly, yet was not a ghost because he could eat and drink and of course at the end Jesus ascends to heaven. Jesus' resurrection body was a new body - his earthly body had gone a new life had begun.

As Christians we sometimes talk about our hope in Christ in vague terms. We speak vaguely about eternal life and often come out with well-rehearsed platitudes when a loved one has died such as 'they've gone to a better place'.

Yet the Resurrection gives us certainty about our specific hope in Christ. The Resurrection gives us hope that when we die; we too will have new bodies (see 1 Corinthians 15) that will no longer be subject to pain, decay and death. Our bodies will be different; but that is because in Christ we are made a new creation. As St Paul declares 'Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: the old has gone, the new is here!' (2 Corinthians 5: 17).

In this Easter season, let's look forward with confidence to the certain hope that we have in the Risen Christ
