## **Editorial**

3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent Reading: Luke 3 v 7-18

In our reading this week; as John the Baptist prepares the way and proclaims the good news that Jesus is coming;


the crowds respond by asking John the Baptist 'What should we do then?'.

In response, John teaches the crowds; if you have heard the good news and repented and been baptised; then you need to be good news and start practically living out the values of the kingdom which Jesus came to establish. Kingdom values such as hope, peace, joy and love.

In this season of Advent, we reflect on these values as we light our Advent Wreath. Today is Gaudete Sunday, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent, where we particularly focus on the kingdom value of joy.

In this season of Advent; as we too ask the question 'What shall we do then?' in response to the coming of Jesus, we remember that as Christians we are called not just to speak good news but to BE good news as we demonstrate the Kingdom values of hope, peace, joy and love.

I wonder: how might you show hope, peace, joy and love to others this week as we seek to be good news in our community?

## Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> December


#### 10am Christingle Carol Service
