Editorial

1st Sunday of Lent

Reading: : Luke 19 v 29-38

The crowd that followed Jesus to Bethsaida pursued Him with eagerness, despite their hunger and exhaustion. They longed to be in His presence, believing He had the words of life. Do we seek Him with the same passion? When difficulties arise, do we turn to Him first, or do we try to solve our problems on our own?

The disciples saw an impossible situation—thousands of hungry people with only five loaves and two fish—we, too, often face challenges that seem insurmountable. Instead of trusting in Jesus' power, we focus on our limitations, forgetting that He is the One who provides abundantly.

Jesus' response to the hungry crowd was not frustration but compassion. He saw their need and met it, just as He will do the same for us .When we bring our struggles—no matter how small or impossible they seem—He will make it possible.

The little boy's lunch fed thousands, and the disciples, who first doubted, later carried twelve baskets of leftovers—the 12 Basket of leftovers were a personal lesson for each disciple to trust him.

This miracle, like the overflowing wine at Cana, points to a greater truth: Jesus not only meets physical needs but also satisfies our deepest spiritual hunger. His broken body and shed blood are the ultimate provision, offering forgiveness, joy, and eternal life.

So, will you trust Him? Will you surrender your worries, your fears, and your limited resources to His hands? When we choose to trust and obey, Jesus will transform our struggles into testimonies


