#### **Pentecost**

Reading: Acts 2 v 1-21

Well, this Sunday used and still is called Whitsunday, which started the Church's period of Whitsuntide. As the years have passed by, this period has become known as Pentecost. Which is recorded in the second Chapter of The Acts of the Apostles. This period is now known as 'The Birthday of the Church when the Holy Spirit of God came upon the Apostles, who were still hiding in the upper room afraid to go out, afraid of being persecuted. It was with 'Great power', that the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles, that they then went out amongst the people of Jerusalem, Peter began to preach to the crowds with great conviction. Such was the power of the Holy Spirit that 2,000 were added to the Church's number that day, this was the very beginning of the Christian Church, The Holy Spirit was given liberty that very first day, and immediately the church was given Holy Power to GROW! And grow it did. God's people were given the liberty to grow in Grace by the Power of God's Holy Spirit.

Do not underestimate the Power of God's Holy Spirit, in your prayer time, ask God to fill you with the Power of His Holy Spirit, and to fill you with His Grace, and because you ask He will answer your prayer, but it must be asked with faith in your heart, and because you have asked God will make you a powerhouse for Him, and you will be a conduit for the Holy Spirit, plugged in to the will and love of God.
