Editorial

9th Sunday after Trinity

Reading: Judges 6 v 11-24

Gideon

In our series of Old Testament leaders we are today looking at Gideon. He was a military leader, a judge, and a prophet but when God came to him, he was frightened and hiding in a wine press, milling grain to keep it from the Midianites.

After the Israelites had been led out of Egypt by Moses they had again turned away from God to worship gods of Baal they were trusting themselves not God. Soon they were taken over by the Midianites, who then controlled their food resources and forced them again into slavery. Gideon took time to trust God .He was given various signs i.e. fire, a wet or dry fleece ,but also God insisted that the army was reduced from 32,000 to 300 which did not appear to be a sensible move.

The reduction in manpower was so it could have seen that the power and success came from God not man. As Gideon was to learn like so many of us not once, but several times Gods ways are best. God can and does use tough and difficult times to show us His ways and the power of His grace. Indeed, the tough times can be used by God to get our attention and then hopefully we will listen to Him.

The fact is that God knows the whole picture and the ending we do not, so we often get things out of perspective, and when things are going well, we appear not to rely upon God.

We are planning new things for the people of St Bede and the community of Morris Green .There are exciting times to come. These include new series of teaching and building plans as we seek to share with others the power and love of God. We don't need ask God for signs and tests but instead thank Him for the wonders of His grace as we move forward . Our part in the future church growth is to be obedient to God, to say yes when He calls us into the unknown and to trust Him for what is to come in the future.

We like Gideon may not have the resources, but God has, and by prayer He will show us and say to us "This is the way walk ye in it"

Please do spread the word and if you know of any children or families who you think would be interested, do encourage them to come along.






Sunday 7th September 10am, St Bede Church


