

13th Sunday after Trinity/Holy Cross Day

Reading: Luke 16 v1-16

This Sunday is Stewardship Sunday, the challenge for this Sunday is for us to take a look at a very serious part of our lives and existence. As soon as we are conceived, we should begin by degrees to look at our responsibilities, because as soon as we enters creation, God welcomes us as one of His Children into His created world. This world is not ours, it does not belong to us, it is God's, likewise our possessions, all that we 'own' is not ours, we are simply custodians of it, it is entrusted to us by Almighty God, creator of the world and everything in it.

If our earthly parents gave us a house to live in, and to care for over the years, if we lived there and did not look after it and allowed it to fall into disrepair, how would we feel when they called us to account for our neglect and lack of care, our selfishness? Unless we were utterly without shame, we would feel nothing. Otherwise we would feel utterly ashamed and wish the ground would open up and swallow us!

Jesus teaches us to be obedient to the Call of God upon us, all Jesus is asking us to do, is to be faithful, to His Call and Word. To care for His creation and to recognise God's vital part in creation, and to realise that our part in His creation is but transitory, and as we pass through be a shrewd tenant. We cannot serve two masters, 'God and money', we can only serve one, 'GOD.'

PAUSE CAFÉ – WHAT IS IT ALL ABOUT

Pause runs monthly as a support cafe in the Community Room at St Bede. It is open to anyone and takes the form of an unstructured support group where people can talk or just listen in a safe, warm space. The group is adaptable to whatever the needs are - even if someone wants to talk 1-1 this can be accommodated and there are plenty of signposting materials available.

Since starting the group I have opened a Facebook page and am looking at a website - I am trying to put the word out to as many people in the area as possible. Through social media we have had a few people reaching out to us but sometimes they don't feel ready to attend. By running the group we are offering support to people if and when they are ready to accept it. We may have to wait months before those people get the courage to come along - but when they do we will be there to welcome them.

Over the coming months I am looking at maybe running a few sessions on mindfulness in the group to see if I can break down some of the barriers in actually making it through the door.

St Bede Reordering Project Gift Day 2025

Dear Member of St Bede Church

As a church we would like to take this opportunity to update you on the reordering plans for St Bede Church and invite you to prayerfully consider financially contributing to the project to help us to grow in our mission as we seek to live for Jesus at the heart of our community.

Over the last couple of years we have seen exciting new growth at St Bede; with the introduction of our midweek WOW service which has effectively doubled the size of our congregation and outreach into our community with our new PAUSE café. God is powerfully at work here in this place! Yet we are now in a position where our community room is not big enough for WOW or the events that we want to hold in church and our church entrance and toilet block is in great need of refurbishment and requires improvements to make our church accessible for all.

As you are aware; our PCC have been working closely with our church architect to draw up plans to redevelop the entrance, toilet block and community room so that our facilities are better equipped to support the growth that we are currently seeing. This includes:

- Expanding the Community Room into Church with bi-fold doors to make our building more flexible
- · Refurbishing the toilet block and introducing disabled and baby-changing facilities
- Building a new external glazed porch to improve our welcome space

We will share the latest proposed plans at the back of church for you to see the plans in more detail.

This project is a step of faith for us as a church; as it will have significant costs. As we move forward with these plans we will need huge financial support. We hope we will cover most of our costs through grant funding, but we as a church will also need to contribute to these costs ourselves.

Therefore this month we are setting up a reordering project fund and are holding a Reordering Project Gift Day on Sunday 13th September to launch our fund. Please could you prayerfully consider whether next week you could make a financial gift towards our re-ordering project?
