

Editorial

2nd Sunday before Advent

Reading: Genesis 22 v 1-18

Our bible reading this week is a shocking story. After an amazing journey through trial and difficulty and trusting the promises of God and many years of waiting, Abraham and Sarah finally receive the long awaited gift of a child. "Abraham was a hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him." Imagine the joy they must have felt.


What happens next is beyond belief. God 'tests' Abraham's faith by asking him to give up Isaac, the son he loves and waited twenty-five years for. God calls Abraham to sacrifice his one and only Son.

Abraham hears the voice of God asking him to do something unthinkable and Abraham obeys. His obedience is based on trust. God has been with him from the beginning of his journey of faith until now and so he trusts God.

This reminds us that serving God is not always easy, and sometimes we have to be willing to make sacrifices and pay the cost. We need to exhibit the character qualities of Abraham.

How can we mature in our faith and obedience to God when He calls us to make sacrifices in our own lives, as we seek to serve and worship Him?

Saturday 22nd November


10am St Bede Christmas Fayre
